Bad knees win two bonspiels

Two skips with bad knees were winners last weekend in two 24-team events at the Marpole and Delta Thistle clubs. Al Roemer (third Vic Miller, second Dennis Jeffels, lead Greg Turner) won the Bud Will men's bonspiel at Delta Thistle CC for the second straight year, defeating Mel Steffin in an extra-end A final. Roemer has been hampered with knee problems for several years and has altered his slide to compensate. Steffin climbed to the top of the Tour points standings with the A final finish.

At Marpole CC, Thomas Friesen (third Aaron Gallant, second Jack Chow, lead Joe Wisniowski) won the A final over Marpole club mate Rod Rawson using a stick delivery. Friesen has been curling with a stick this season while waiting for knee surgery. Rawson had a chance for four in the eighth end to tie the game but wasn't able to capitalize.
