Seniors beat young guys for Tour's richest prize

The Kevin Jeannotte team from Langley (Kent Royer, Bill Tallentire, Brad Snyder) walked away with \$2000 on Sunday at Tunnel Town CC to pick up the richest prize on Tour this season. Jeannotte's team, a senior men's playdowns team, knocked off a much younger men's playdowns team, skipped by Andrew Bilesky of Royal City CC, in the A final. Bilesky currently leads the competitive Premium League at Royal City and won the 2001 BC junior men's championship. His team picked up \$1000 for second place. Jeannotte had missed being in the prizes in four previous bonspiels this season.

The Tunnel Town CC offered the richest purse on Tour this season as part of their 50th anniversary celebrations and secured many sponsors for the event. The field of 40 teams was full weeks before the bonspiel. With a runner-up finish in the B event, Mike Weir has taken over the Tour points standings lead from Mel Steffin.
