Frycz wins with non-tour team

Darren Frycz of Langley has been a strong force on the Region 11 Men's Bonspiel Tour since inception last season, winning the first points race. This season he's playing third on a tour team skipped by Mark Gilchrist of Langley that appears to have a guaranteed spot in the tour championship. Last weekend in Cloverdale Frycz took another Langley team into the bonspiel and won the A final over Bruce Currie from the host club.

Frycz's brother Don from Delta Thistle was a factor too with his tour team, losing the B final to another tour team skipped by Darrell Zbeetnoff from Peace Arch. Don Frycz took over the tour points lead though, edging ahead of Chris Faa's Vancouver team that missed qualifying in the bonspiel. Kevan Penonzek of Gibsons, with Jared Wannamaker throwing fourth stones, won the C final over Richard Christie from Peace Arch.

Losing out in the A semi-finals were Bruce Feltham and Al MacKinnon, both from Langley, while Cloverdale's Bob Lederer and Tunnel Town's Richard Brower reached the B semi-finals and Ken Harward of Cloverdale and Glen Ganges made it to the C semi-finals.
