Conlin takes Peace Arch spiel

The David Conlin rink (Dave Bergen, Troy Scott, Norm Clark) from Cloverdale not only won the first Peace Arch CC men's bonspiel yesterday in the new facility, but also qualified for the Tour Championship in the process. Conlin headed into the eighth end of the A event final tied with Darrell Hrynkiw from the host club, but holding the hammer. On the final rock of the game he executed a light-weight takeout on a partially buried rock beside the four-foot to win the game. Winning the game actually earned the Conlin team \$20 less than they would have received for losing it, as they had the Hrynkiw team in the blind Calcutta.
