2010 BC Mixed & Stick champions declared

Richmond, BC (March 22, 2010) – The 2010 BC Open Stick Curling Championship was held in Armstrong from March 12-14, hosting twenty-four two-person teams. This was only the second BC stick championship but definitely won't be the last. Popularity is on the rise in this category with the number of participants tripling from last year's championship held in Maple Ridge.

It was a repeat win for the 2009 champs of Tim Smith and John Campbell who represented the host club.

The Chilliwack Curling Club hosted the 2010 Williams Moving & Storage BC Mixed Curling Championship presented by Merit Travel this past week. The Tom Buchy rink of Lori Buchy, Dave Toffolo and Robyn Toffolo from the Kimberley Curling Club defeated Royal City's Doug Meger in the final game. The high scoring final went to an extra-end and finished 12-11 in Buchy's favour.

Buchy went undefeated through the 8 team round-robin event. Meger advanced to the final after defeating Salmon Arm's Dave Belway.

Buchy now advances to the 2011 Canadian Mixed Curling Championship in Morris, Manitoba, November 13-20th.
