Cormack wins 2011 BC Wheelchair Curling Championship

Richmond, BC (February 7, 2011) Gary Cormack and teammates Frank LaBounty, Vince Miele and Allison Duddy went undefeated this past weekend at the Kimberley Curling Club to capture the 2011 BC Wheelchair Curling Championship.

Cormack began his weekend by defeating Jim Armstrong 6-3, followed by a 10-2 victory over Bob MacDonald's rink. His 2-0 record placed him in Sunday's final.

Armstrong bounced back to defeat MacDonald 12-0, but faced him a second time in Sunday morning's semi-final. MacDonald stole singles in the 4th, 5th and 6th ends to advance to the provincial final by a score of 6-5.

MacDonald opened the final game with a single-point steal, but gave up 6 point in the following three ends. Cormack maintained control in the final ends, running MacDonald out of stones in the 8th and winning by a final score of 8-3.
