### **Jurgenson wins 2010 Canadian Senior Women's Curling Championship**

Richmond, BC (March 29, 2010) – Christine Jurgenson and her Juan de Fuca Curling Club team of Cheryl Noble, Pat Sanders and Roselyn Craig now have two Canadian Senior Women's Championship titles to their names.

Jurgenson received a bye to Sunday's final after finishing the round-robin in first place at 9-2. She controlled the bulk of the final game against New Brunswick's Heidi Hanlon and entered the 8<sup>th</sup> end with a one point lead and last rock advantage. However, their lead quickly disappeared after giving up a steal of two and trailing 6-5 with two ends remaining. The BC squad remained focused and executed a double take-out in the 9<sup>th</sup> end to secure five points and a four point lead coming home. They went on to run New Brunswick out of rocks and capture the win by a final score of 10-6.

This BC team also captured the 2008 Canadian Senior and 2009 World Senior Championships with Jurgenson throwing lead stones, Craig at second and Sanders skipping the game. The team decided to change the line-up this season in order to spread the spotlight across all four players.

The team will now represent Canada at the 2011 World Senior Curling Championship in St. Paul, Minnesota, April 15-24, 2011.

Wes Craig (husband to Roselyn Craig) along with Phil Olsen, Tony Anslow and Blair Cusack also represented the Juan de Fuca Curling Club on the men's side of the competition. They finished in 7<sup>th</sup> place with a record of 5-6.
