### **Kelly Scott off to the 2009 Tim Hortons Roar of the Rings**

Richmond, BC (December 4, 2009) – The Kelly Scott rink of Jeanna Schraeder, Sasha Carter, Jacquie Armstrong, fifth Helen Radford and coach Gerry Richard are on their way to Edmonton, AB for the 2009 Tim Hortons Roar of the Rings. Here they will compete against seven of the top women's teams in the country for the right to represent Canada at the 2010 Olympic Winter Games in Vancouver.

This will be Scott's second attempt at the title after losing a nail biter trials final in 2005 to Alberta's Shannon Kleibrink. The Kelowna team has gained some valuable experience over the past four years by adding two Canadian titles and one World title to their resume.
