Youth compete to represent BC at the 2011 Canada Winter Games

Vernon, BC (November 5, 2010) Four boys' and four girls' teams will compete at the Vernon Curling Club this weekend, for the right to represent BC at the 2011 Canada Winter Games to be held in Halifax this February.

Teams will begin a four-team round-robin on Saturday morning at 8:30am, with the top two in each category advancing to the final games on Sunday at 10:30am.

Teams qualified for this playdown by either medaling at the 2010 BC Winter Games or by winning a qualifier event held in Cloverdale last month. The top boys' and girls' teams will advance to the 2011 Canada Winter Games in Halifax, NS, February 11-27, 2011.
