DEADLINE AFTER DRAW 8	Nomination form: Fair Play begins with the strict observance of the written rule; however, in most cases, Fair Play involves something more than even unfailing observance of the written rule. The observance of the spirit of the rules, whether written or unwritten, is important. Fair Play results from measuring up to one's own moral standards while engaged in competition. Fair Play is a consistent demonstration of respect for teammates and opponents, whether they are winning





or losing. Fair Play is a consistent demonstration of respect for umpires, an acceptance of their decisions and a steadfast spirit of collaboration with them. Fair Play behaviour should be demonstrated both on and off the ice. This includes modesty in victory and composure in defeat.
