**Location:**

The rink is located at 4856 Dunn Lake Rd in Barriere. Enter town at the Petro Canada (which is the main street Barriere Town Rd). Stay on this main road all the way to the curling rink. You will travel through the community, over a bridge and through a 3-way stop. Barriere Town Rd will change at the 3-way stop to Dunn Lake Rd.

**Accommodations:**

We have booked a bank of rooms at both the Monte Carlo Motel 250-672-9676 or Mountain Springs Motel 250-672-0090. These hotels are both on the highway. There are a couple of others available if necessary.

**Schedule:**

We will have a Welcome luncheon for the athletes at 12:30 pm before the Opening ceremonies at 1:30 pm on Thursday, February 6<sup>th</sup>.

We will be providing muffins, fruit and water in the locker room for athletes to have between games.

A banquet will take place Friday at 5:00 pm in our lounge upstairs for curlers, Curl BC reps, and volunteers. There will be **additional tickets** available for visiting guests that can be purchased for \$15.00. **Please let us know in advance if you would like to purchase any tickets.** *Please contact us if there are any dietary needs or allergies that we need to be aware of.*

**Club Facilities and Services:**

1. Lockers will be available for all team members. Please bring your own lock. There is no room to change in the locker room, but the handicap stall in the washrooms is quite spacious to change in for the women.

2. The concession will be open daily serving a variety of home cooked menu items. The times are Thursday 8:30 - 6:00 pm, Friday 8:00 - 3:30 pm, Saturday 9:00 - 2:00 pm. Serving 3 varieties of soup & biscuit daily, hamburgers, hot dogs, fries, sandwiches.
